I am writing to express my opposition to the three candidate plans (A+, B+ and D+) proposed by the Study Board. Without upper and lower water level limits, all three pose significant risk to the south shore communities of Lake Ontario. High water levels would flood the communities around Sodus Bay. Low water conditions would make recreational boating in Sodus Bay impossible.

As a (recreational boater/resident/tax payer/concerned citizen, etc.) I urge you to retain the current operating Plan 1958-D with Deviations.
