

Dear Sir,

We are writing to express our opposition to the three candidate plans (A+, B+ and D+) proposed by the Study Board. Without upper and lower water level limits, all three pose significant risk to the south shore communities of Lake Ontario. High water levels would hamper both private and public property and flood the communities around Sodus Bay. Low water conditions would make recreational boating on Lake Ontario impossible causing great loses to many communities who depend on this for part of their livelihood.

As concerned tax payers who are also a recreational boaters, we urge you to retain the current operating Plan 1958-D with Deviations.
