Without upper and lower water level limits, all three pose significant risk to the south shore communities of Lake Ontario. High water levels would flood the communities around Sodus Bay. Low water conditions would make recreational boating in Sodus Bay impossible.

As a homeowner, tax payer recreational boater and concerned citizen, we urge you to retain the current operating Plan 1957-D with Revisions
