
I am writing in regards to the Plan B+ for the restoration of Lake Ontario and the St. Lawrence River. I am in full support of adopting this international water level management plan. I grew up in Rochester and as a child I swam in Lake Ontario all through the summer, until it was shut down because of pollution and poor water levels. It has since reopened but on a very sporadic schedule. I think it is an important attraction for the Rochester area.

It is also my understanding; by adopting this Plan B+ it will significantly improve the fish species.
