Louisville, Ky. on the River since 1960.

I am a widow of 61 yrs,
77 yrs. old, alone, & was deeded this
property as "life's use" from my father
who "loved" me dearly, and his
canequiver.

My "dear" father had a
beautiful "L-shaped" deck built over
the water. It is not a dock per se,
but an addition to our porch, with
railings, lights, flowers, & a canopy built
over a portion of the "deck" to help
fish & entertain in the shade. The
only such structure on this
beautiful river. (In this area.)

The "deck" is over a 100 feet
long & we spent most of the day,
relaxing, fishing, entertaining, eating, &
enjoying the view of the ships, sailboats,
watercraft; etc. Paradise, for sure!

Due to high water & winds in
the Springtime our beautiful deck was
destroyed in 2002.

Consequently to satisfy my dear father's wisher and keep & maintain this deck, I had a new structure built for \$18,000.

With a fixed income I mortgaged my home to help defray the ~~costs~~ -

Even though I'm 77 yrs. old, I still love to vsp the River, with a kayak, hydrobike, peddle boat & my weekly swim, a quarter mile across the river.

The beautiful deck is my "hide & joy" as it was my dad's. At the end of my day I lounge, eat, play music & dance etc & enjoy the activity on the river; from the beautiful, scenic view on this deck!

I only ask you to keep water levels "top" in the Springtime - April - May & maybe June so my "vital" deck is not destroyed again.

My understanding is plan 2007

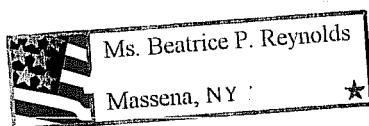
will raise the water levels during
