

## INTERNATIONAL JOINT COMMISSION

Directive Creating the International  
St. Lawrence River Board of Control.

The requirements of the International Joint Commission, hereinafter called "the Commission", with regard to the design, construction, maintenance and operation of the works for development of power in the International Rapids Section of the St. Lawrence River according to the Applications in like terms submitted to the Commission by the Governments of the United States and Canada respectively under date of 30 June, 1952, are set forth in the Order of Approval issued by the Commission under date of 29 October, 1952.

Provision is made in the said Order of Approval for the establishment by the Commission of a Board to be known as the International St. Lawrence River Board of Control, and pursuant thereto the Commission hereby orders and directs:

- (1) That the International St. Lawrence River Board of Control, hereinafter called the "Board of Control", be and is hereby established, to consist of a United States Section and a Canadian Section, each Section to be comprised of four

members, one of whom shall be Section Chairman. The two Sections of the Board of Control and the Chairmen thereof shall be nominated by the respective Sections of the Commission and appointed by the Commission;

(2) That the Board of Control shall perform the duties specifically assigned to it in the Commission's Order of Approval dated 29 October, 1952, a copy of which is attached to this Directive;

(3) That the relationship between the Board of Control and the St. Lawrence River Joint Board of Engineers, the United States entity, the Canadian entity, and the Commission shall, unless otherwise ordered by the Commission, be as set forth in said Order of Approval;

(4) That in addition to the reports which are to be made to the International Joint Commission in accordance with the terms of said Order of Approval, the Board of Control shall report at the Commission's semi-annual meetings in April and October and also shall keep the Commission currently informed with regard to the discharge of water from Lake Ontario and the flow through the International Rapids Section of the St. Lawrence River, especially during the period of construction of the works.
