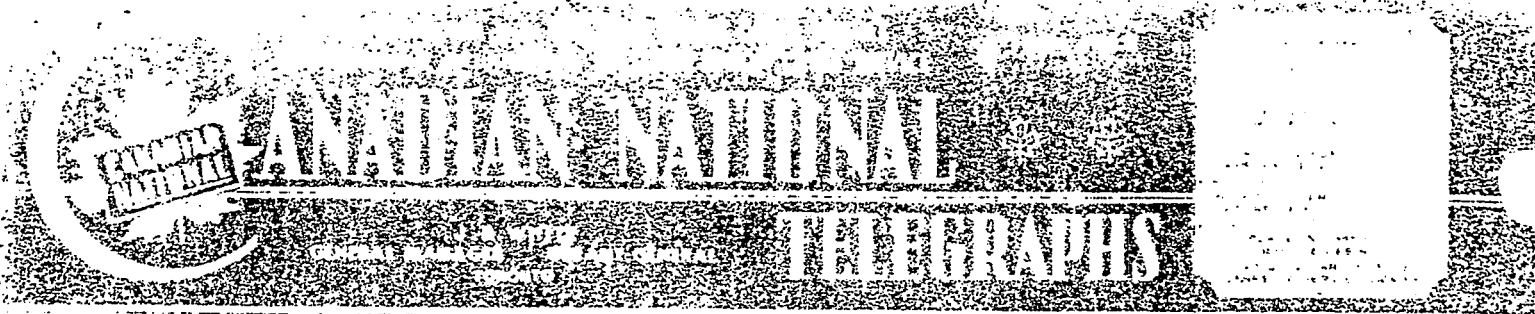

THE INTERNATIONAL JOINT COMMISSION HAS CONSIDERED THE BOARD'S TELEGRAMS OF 18 AUGUST 1960 OUTLINING THE MANNER IN WHICH IT PROPOSES TO FUNCTION IN THE DISCHARGE OF ITS TECHNICAL RESPONSIBILITIES IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE INSTRUCTIONS OF THE COMMISSION AND TO PROVIDE, INSOFAR AS POSSIBLE, OPTIMUM CONDITIONS FOR ALL INTERESTS CONCERNED WITHIN THE SCOPE OF THE CRITERIA AND OTHER REQUIREMENTS OF THE ORDERS OF APPROVAL. STOP.

THE COMMISSION ACCEPTS THESE PROPOSALS IN PRINCIPLE AND DIRECTS THE BOARD SPECIFICALLY AS FOLLOWS:

1. THE BOARD WILL CONTINUE TO CALCULATE THE WEEKLY FLOW RELEASE WHICH IS IN ACCORDANCE WITH PLAN 1958-A AND WHICH WILL SATISFY THE CRITERIA AND OTHER CONDITIONS ESTABLISHED BY THE IJC IN THE ORDERS OF APPROVAL DATED 29 OCTOBER 1952 and 2 JULY 1956. STOP.
2. HAVING REGARD TO THE TERMS OF THE UNITED STATES FEDERAL POWER COMMISSION ORDER ON REHEARING, DATED 3 AUGUST 1959, AND TO THE CANADIAN ORDER IN COUNCIL P.C. 1959-506, DATED 23 APRIL 1959,

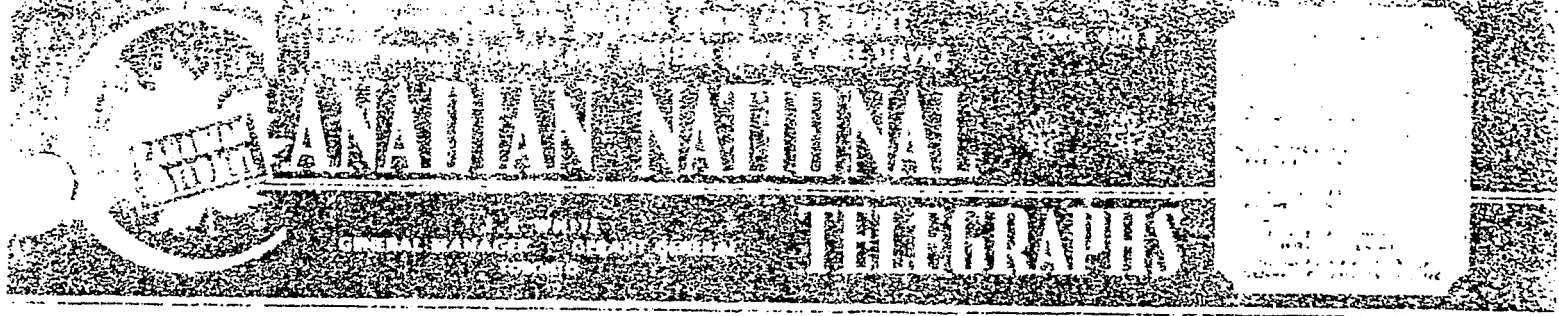
THE BOARD WILL MAKE THE INFORMATION REFERRED TO IN PARAGRAPH 1 ABOVE AVAILABLE FOR USE IN THE OPERATION OF THE PROJECT FACILITIES APPROVED BY THE COMMISSION'S ORDERS

(A) IN THE UNITED STATES, TO THE POWER AUTHORITY OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK;

(B) IN CANADA, TO THE MINISTER OF TRANSPORT OR HIS DULY AUTHORIZED REPRESENTATIVES, MR. I.M. PATTERSON AND MR. D.M. RIPLEY, FOR SUPPLY TO THE HYDRO-ELECTRIC POWER COMMISSION OF ONTARIO. STOP.

3. IN ORDER TO PROVIDE CONVENIENT OPPORTUNITY TO OBTAIN THE VIEWS OF THE SEVERAL INTERESTS CONCERNED IN THE REGULATION OF FLOW IN THE ST. LAWRENCE RIVER, THE BOARD WILL, AFTER CONSULTING WITH THE COMMISSION, ESTABLISH A QUOTE ST. LAWRENCE RIVER OPERATIONS ADVISORY GROUP UNQUOTE COMPOSED OF ONE OR MORE REPRESENTATIVES OF EACH OF THE INTERESTS AS DEEMED APPROPRIATE BY THE BOARD. STOP. THESE MEMBERS WILL BE CONSULTED INDIVIDUALLY OR COLLECTIVELY BY THE BOARD OR BY THE REPRESENTATIVES OF THE RESPECTIVE SECTIONS OF THE BOARD AS THE OCCASION MAY REQUIRE. STOP.

4. IN ORDER TO PROVIDE FOR THE PROMPT REMEDIAL ACTION WHICH MAY BE NECESSARY UNDER WINTER OPERATIONS OR EMERGENCY CONDITIONS THE BOARD WILL DESIGNATE A REPRESENTATIVE FOR EACH SECTION OF THE



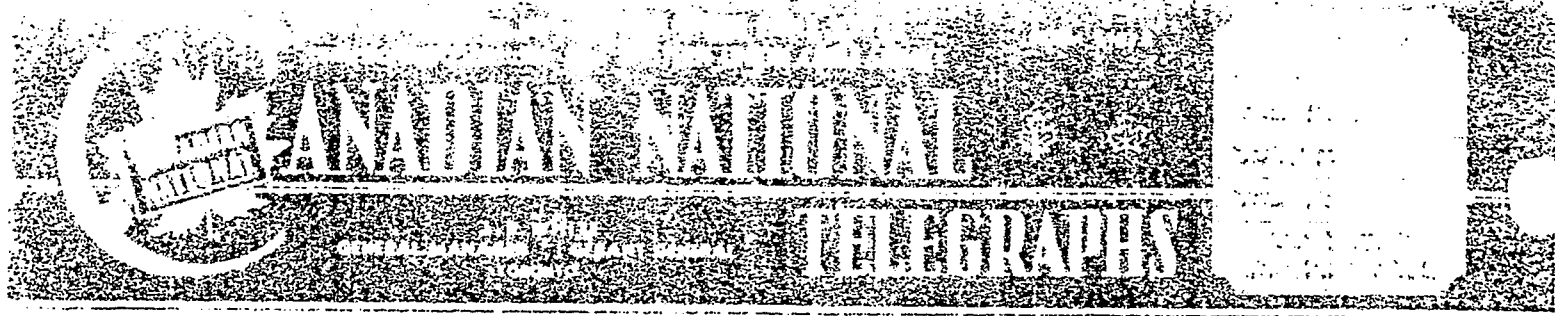

BOARD WHO MAY BE AUTHORIZED BY THE BOARD TO SUPPLY INFORMATION TO THE PERSONS NAMED IN PARAGRAPH 2 FOR THE USE OF THE RESPECTIVE POWER ENTITIES. AS TO DEVIATIONS FROM THE NORMAL APPLICATION OF THE PLAN WHICH WOULD BE ACCEPTABLE TO THE BOARD TO MEET SUCH CONDITIONS. STOP.

5. THE BOARD WILL KEEP THE COMMISSION CURRENTLY INFORMED OF THE MEMBERSHIP OF THE ST. LAWRENCE RIVER OPERATIONS ADVISORY GROUP AND THE INTERESTS THEY REPRESENT. STOP.

6. THE BOARD WILL KEEP THE COMMISSION CURRENTLY INFORMED AS TO THE INSTRUCTIONS AND AUTHORITY GIVEN TO THE REPRESENTATIVE DESIGNATED FOR EACH SECTION OF THE BOARD PURSUANT TO PARAGRAPH 4 ABOVE. STOP.

7. THE FOREGOING DIRECTIONS DO NOT AFFECT THE EXISTING INTERIM ARRANGEMENTS WITH RESPECT TO OPERATION OF IROQUOIS DAM AS AUTHORIZED IN THE COMMISSION'S TELEGRAMS OF 31 MARCH 1960, OR TO PEAKING OPERATIONS AT THE BARNHART POWER PLANTS AS AUTHORIZED IN THE COMMISSION'S TELEGRAMS OF 29 APRIL 1960. STOP.

9. NOTHING IN THIS TELEGRAM SHALL DETRACT IN ANY WAY FROM THE DUTIES SPECIFICALLY ASSIGNED TO THE BOARD OF CONTROL IN THE ORDERS OF APPROVAL DATED 20 OCTOBER 1952 and 2 JULY 1956. STOP.

10. THE FOREGOING DIRECTIONS ARE SUBJECT TO SUCH DEVELOPMENT AS THE COMMISSION MAY FIND TO BE EXPEDIENT IN THE LIGHT OF FUTURE EXPERIENCE. STOP.

11. A SIMILAR MESSAGE IS BEING SENT TO THE CHAIRMAN OF THE U.S. SECTION, INTERNATIONAL ST. LAWRENCE RIVER BOARD OF CONTROL BY THE CHAIRMAN OF THE U.S. SECTION, INTERNATIONAL JOINT COMMISSION. STOP.
