Dear Sirs:

I own an irrigated farm on the Milk River Valley, irrigating about 200 acres with sprinklers.

Having attended several hearings on the 1909 Boundaries Treaty and the 1921 Order that implements the water apportionment of the treaty, I have come to the following conclusion.

I would like the division of water to be on an annual accounting, making it possible for me to receive my fair share of the water supply from the St. Mary River. This will allow me to irrigate my crops with an adequate supply of water.

With the high cost of raising a crop on irrigated land, a full supply of water is necessary.
