Dear Sir :-

At our "St. Croix" plant, Milltown, N.B. the old wooden dam over the St. Croix River has become obsolete and is in a dilapidated condition. It is over fifty years old and evidence of weakening and of excessive leakage is causing considerable worry, owing to the possibility of an enforced shutdown of this large mill. We are, therefore, proposing to immediately replace this wooden structure by a concrete structure on the same site. The proposed new structure is shown on our Engineers' drawings Nos. 1-297 and 1-298 enclosed herewith.

You will note that the new structure is similar as to crest elevation with the structure it is replacing and the only change is the inclusion of additional openings for handling the river flow.

As the low-water season is well advanced and as it is imperative that this structure be completed before cold weather sets in, we are commencing reconstruction operations immed-
